## Areas of Practice

### **Matrimonial Finance**

A complex case which involved a very detailed analysis of the current and predicted asset schedule.

*Re T* - Representing Mother, bringing a Schedule 1 application on behalf of her son. Successfully argued that she needed capital in order to rent property, pay for nursery fees and furnish her home.
